

## **GENERAL RULES FOR PARTICIPANTS IN EXPERIMENTAL LICENSE WD2XSH**

The following rules apply to all participants in the WD2XSH experimental license.

### **1. COORDINATION**

As a participants, you must coordinate with the following:

### **2. COMMUNICATION**

The primary means of communication will be by e-mail. You will receive general bulletins via the 500kc.com web site and individual e-mails sent directly. You must inform all three coordinators of any changes in your e-mail address. You are expected to respond promptly to e-mail.

### **3. ADHERING TO RULES**

You must follow all rules set forth by the FCC. You may not operate until receiving an authorization from the Experiment Coordinator, and you must follow additional directions from the Experiment Coordinator (for example, frequency restrictions). You may not communicate with stations that are not included in the license. You may operate only from the location specified in the license.

### **4. GET ON THE AIR AND PARTICIPATE**

All participants will be expected to get on the air in a reasonable amount of time. Participation in certain scheduled activities is also expected.

### **5. LOGS**

All participants must make monthly submissions of logs to the Log Coordinator. Logs are available on the 500kc.com web site and must be submitted in MS Excel format. If you cannot produce an Excel file, contact the Log Coordinator for instructions on how to produce a suitable text file. If there has been no activity, you must submit an e-mail to the Logging Coordinator.

### **6. LACK OF COOPERATION**

Cooperation is essential to make this experiment a success, thus paving the way for a new amateur band. Individuals who do not cooperate will be dropped from the experiment.
